## Teens don't just drink... They drink to excess

### ABOVE THE NATIONAL NORM

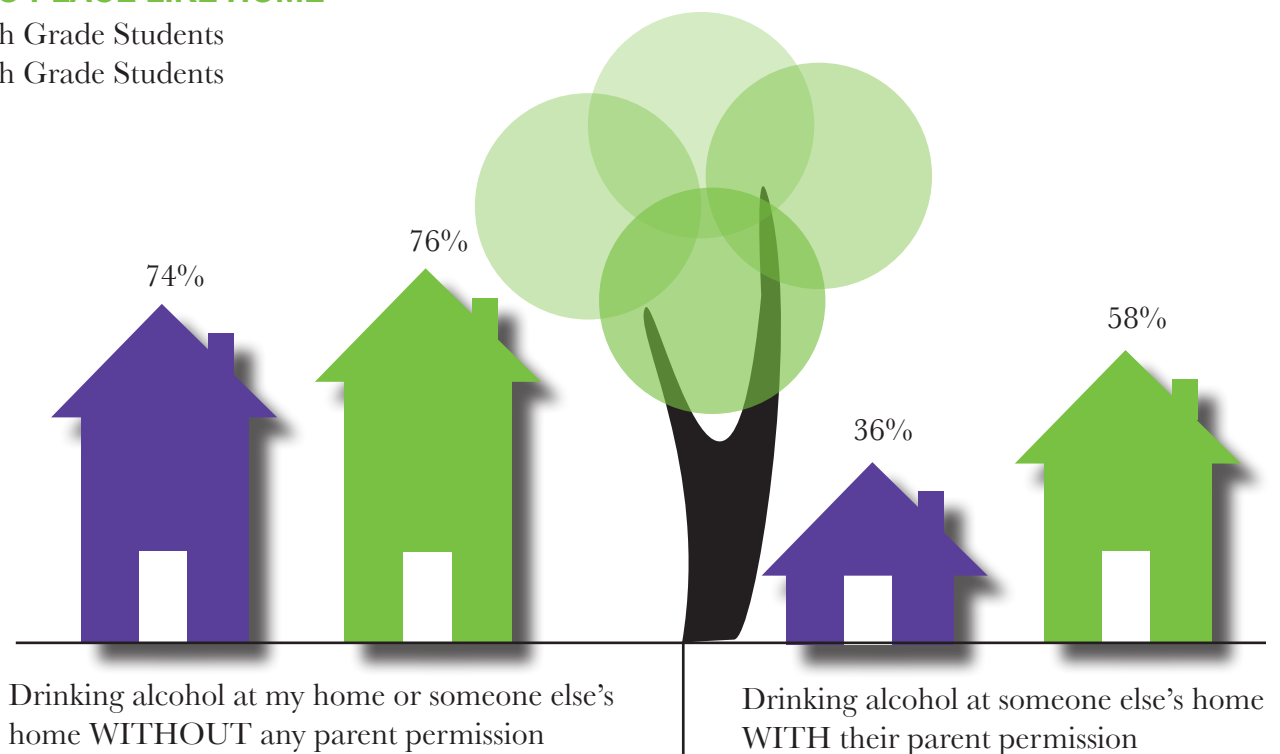
- 61% of 10th graders (135/222) report drinking (not just a sip or taste) in the past year
- 77% of 12th graders (151/197) report drinking (not just a sip or taste) in the past year

The percentage of Manhasset Public School students who report binge drinking (having 5 or more alcoholic drinks in a row in the past 2 weeks - one or more times) doubles from the 10th to 12th grade

- 27% of 10th grade students report binge drinking in the past two weeks
- 54% of 12th grade students report binge drinking in the past two weeks

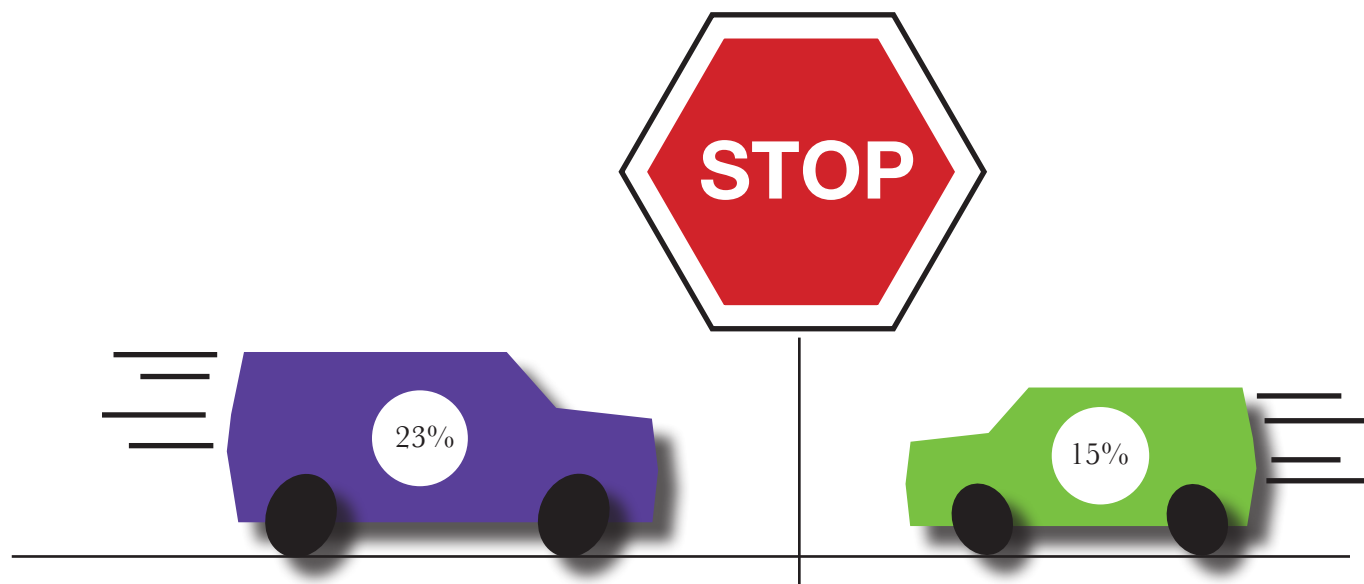
### IN THE PAST YEAR, TEENS WHO REPORT DRINKING HAVE EASY ACCESS TO ALCOHOL

- 80% of these 10th grade students & 92% of these 12th grade students drank alcohol at a house party
- 62% of these 10th grade students & 78 % of these 12th grade students acquired alcohol from someone they knew under age 21
- 50% of these 10th grade students & 77% of these 12th grade students gave someone money to buy it for them
- 42% of these 10th grade students & 52% of these 12th grade students got it from home without their parent's permission

### JUST WHO IS BEHIND THE WHEEL

During the past 30 days, teens who reported binge drinking also ride with a drinking driver

- 10th Grade Students (31/135)
- 12th Grade Students (23/151)
