Facts about Alcohol and Drug Abuse

Collaboration is essential when it comes to providing students with factual information about substance abuse. This fall and winter, CASA, the Manhasset Secondary School Health Teachers and the Middle School SADD Club, established student information centers and bulletin boards to address the dangers of drugs and alcohol. The information centers, installed in the 8th/10th grade health classrooms and middle school commons, offer students brochures that answer questions regarding alcohol, marijuana, inhalant, prescription drug, and tobacco (cigarette and chew) abuse. In addition, the centers provide students information from self-help organizations. Student centers will also be installed by the girls and boys locker rooms and physical education corridor. Throughout the year, the CASA and SADD Bulletin Boards will display updated health information regarding the dangers of substance abuse.
