North Shore Audobon Society presents Michael Scheibel as the Natural Resources manager of the 2,039 acre Mashomack Preserve on Shelter Island. Part of his duties include protection and observation of a pair of bald eagles that have nested there. Is this a trend due to improved environmental conditions, overcrowding in more traditional nesting sites or other reasons he was hired by the Nature Conservancy (TNC) in 1994 as project manager. Recipients of the Basic STAR exemption with one owner over 65 next year can apply for the Enhanced STAR Exemption. Current Enhanced STAR exemption recipients not enrolled in the Income Verification Program must continue to file a renewal application with the Nassau County Department of Assessment each year. The Nassau County Department of Assessment will continue to administer all exemptions, whereas the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance will administer the new STAR Credit Program.
