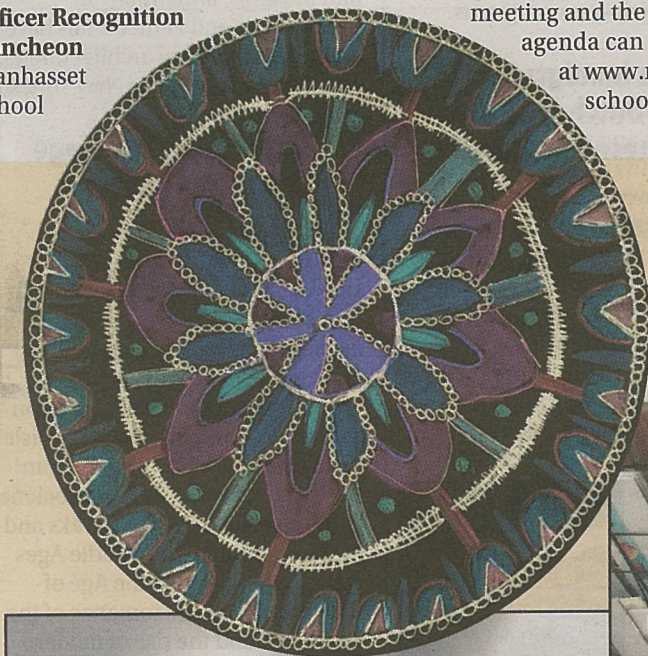
### Veterans Collection
