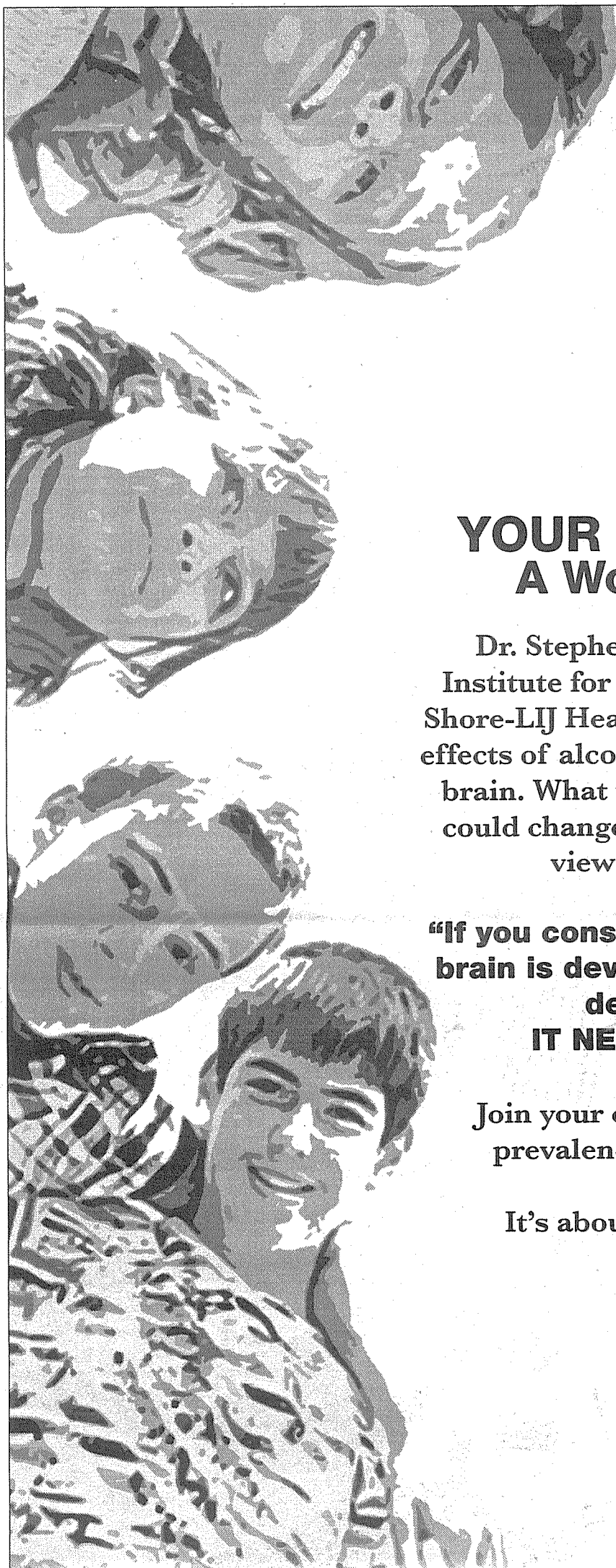

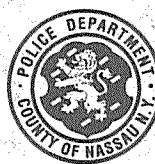

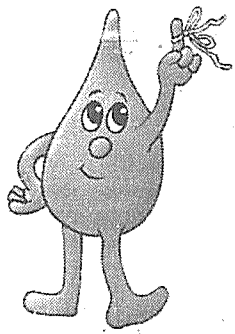
Library Trustee Position To Open

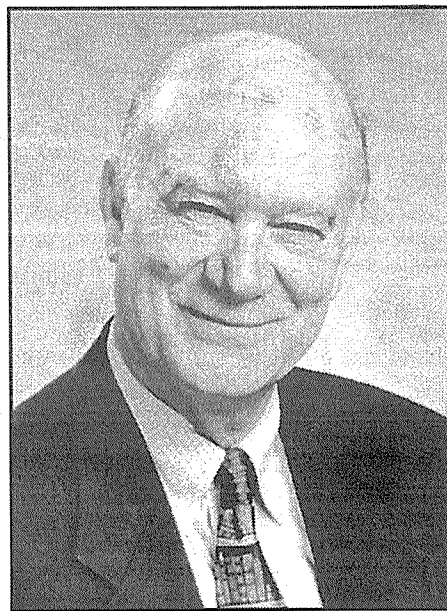

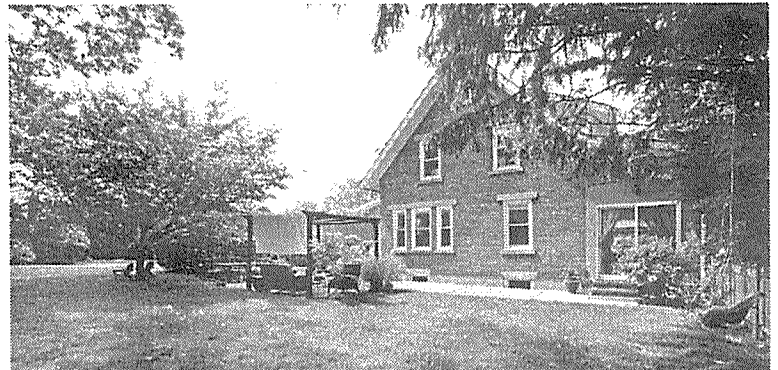
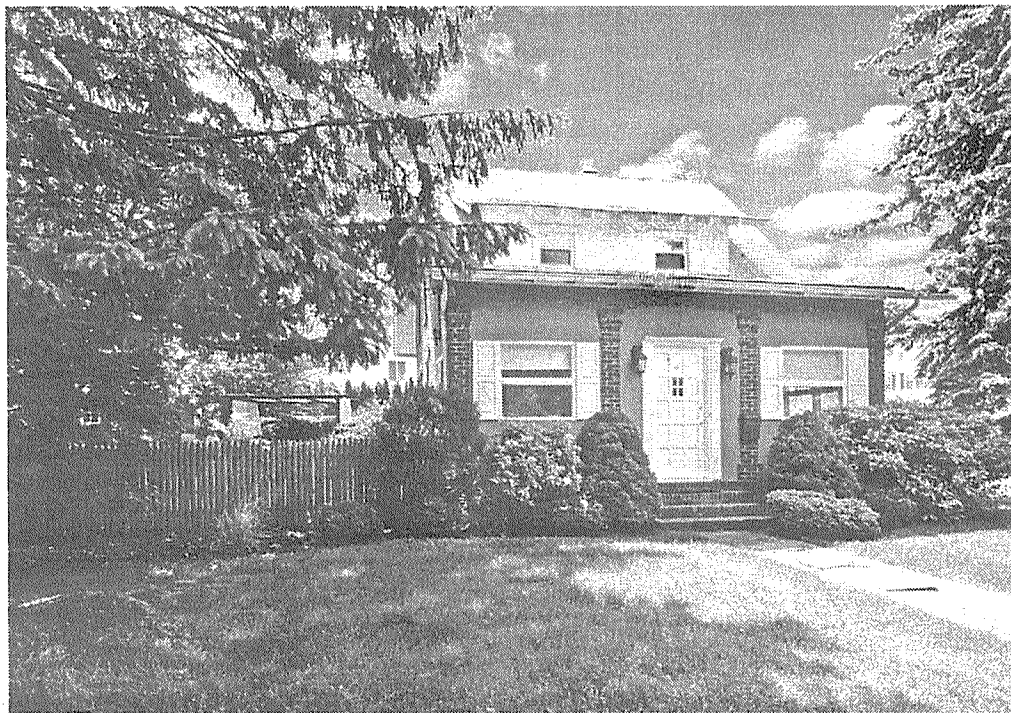
